

SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT FOR SYRACUSE UNIVERSITY DENTAL AND VISION BENEFITS PLAN

This is a summary of the annual report of the Syracuse University Dental and Vision Benefits Plan, a dental and vision plan, Employer Identification Number 15-0532081, Plan Number 520, for the plan year January 1, 2025 through December 31, 2025. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Insurance Information

The plan has insurance contracts with Excellus Blue Cross Blue Shield and Vision Service Plan to pay certain dental and vision claims incurred under the terms of the plan. The total premiums paid for the plan year ending December 31, 2025 were \$3,498,850.

Because the dental contract with Excellus Blue Cross Blue Shield is a so-called "experience-rated" contract, premium costs are affected by, among other things, the number and size of claims. Of the total dental insurance premiums paid for the plan year ending December 31, 2025, the premiums paid under this experience-rated contract were \$3,142,465 and the total of all claims paid under this contract during the plan year was \$3,544,644.
